Who can apply for NWRC Scholarships?

Rental Center Employees, Vendors who sell predominately to the rental industry, and their college age children who live in Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana and Alaska.

Why should apply?

Every student can use a helping hand. Perhaps you are considering continuing your education, or would like to attend a trade or certificate program that will enhance your job skills.

One of the missions of NWRC is to promote education in the rental industry and that applies to adult students of all ages, and at many levels.

What are the requirements for eligibility?

Full or part time students in trade schools, community colleges, or universities are eligible to apply.

Applicants must be in the NWRC 5 state region. Awarded scholarships are paid upon successful completion of the term with at least a C average, and if a full-time student, at least 12 units must be completed.

When do I apply?

NWRC scholarships are awarded twice each year, for fall and spring terms.

Deadlines for submitting your application are June 30 for fall term and December 31 for spring term.
